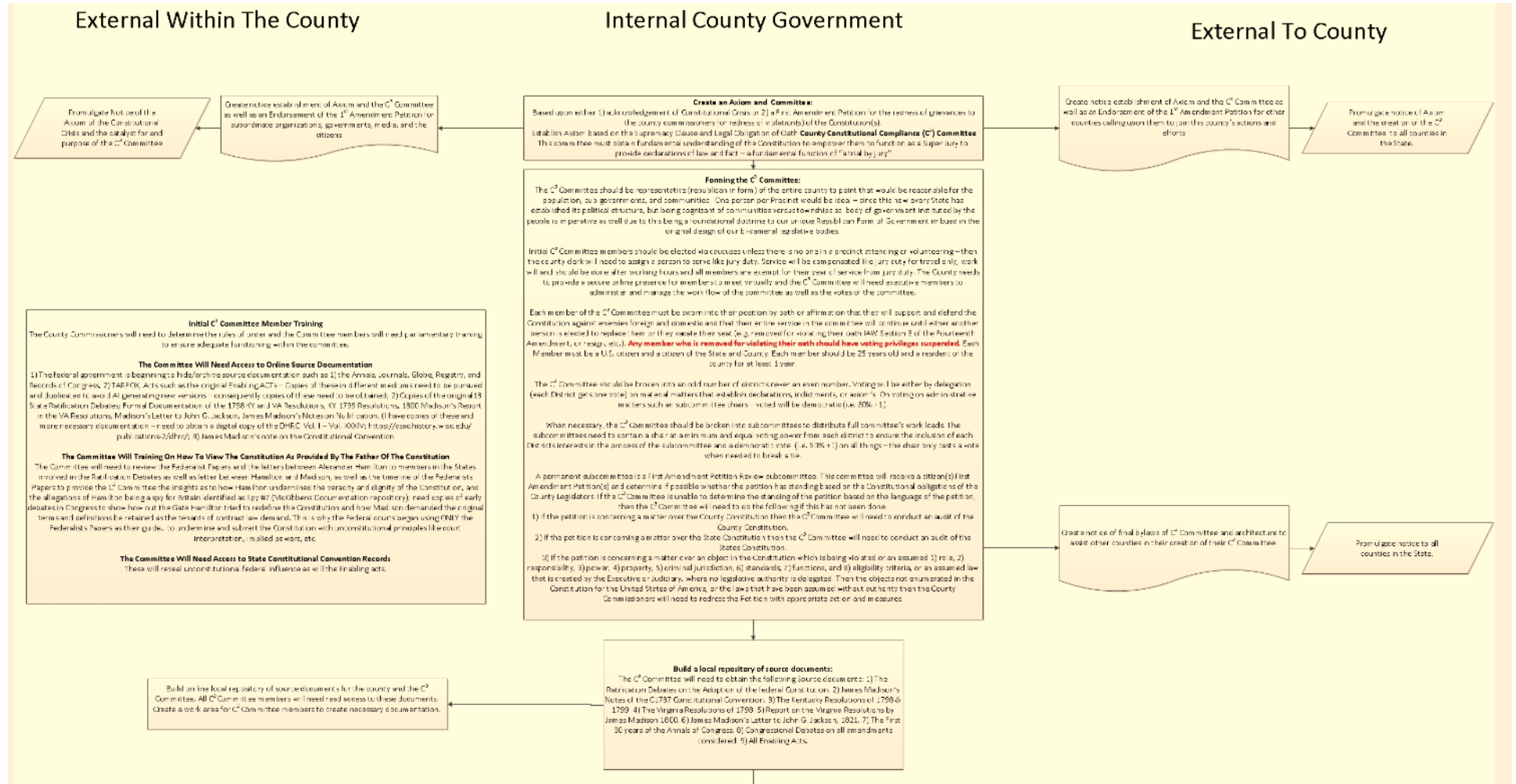


# C3 Committee Flow Chart – GR Mobley – Reclaiming The Republic - Overview



**Canonize / Define The Constitution For The County:**

First: Identify the different versions of the constitution (e.g. the annotated Constitution, the Original Constitution, etc.) based standards explored in formal founding documentation as to how contracts / constitutions are based and function. The source documents for this must be based upon the Ratification Debates as contained in the "found documents" of the creation of the general government of the Federal Constitution. This must also be based upon the reports and standards of contracts law and the nature of powers of attorney and constitutions to determine if the Constitution delegates any authority to the general agreement to create an annotated Constitution where they can assume the authority to define what each word and clause means in the Constitution and how they choose to enforce these restrictions. The Conclusion will be NO there is no power delegated to the general government to keep and maintain how they choose to interpret the Constitution as well as its definition and how they will enforce it.

Second: The C<sup>2</sup> Committee will then create the footnotes to all "word" and "clauses" within the Constitution for the United States of America as to how they were defined by the proponents to the Constitution. (AW contract law assertions made by opponents must be given and not included unless they were rejected by the State ratifying the Constitution for the United States of America.

Create document to Define and Declare the Original Text Of the Constitution as the Supreme Law of the land for the county and announce the counties beginning of the audit of the Federal Constitution.

Promulgate declaration to all counties in the state - invite all counties to initiate or adjoin to the audit process

Create document to provide findings and copy of definitive Constitution with footnotes and citations.

Promulgate definitive Constitution with footnotes and citations to all counties in the State.

Create reports of findings informing all counties in the state of the list of direct and assumed violations to the Constitution that have been identified by the C<sup>2</sup> Committee.

Promulgate reports to all counties in the state requesting involvement and reports in this process

**Conduct Audit of The Federal Constitution**

First: Based upon the now defined federal Constitution identify the objects delegated the general government in the federal Constitution - these objects being 1) rule, 2) responsibility, 3) power, 4) property, 5) criminal jurisdiction, 6) standards, 7) functions, and 8) eligibility criteria. Using the reports submitted on to each clause that explains the cause. Then review all departments, agencies, offices, and any other entity or function that requires funding - any department, agency, office, and any other entity or function that requires funding that is not directly derived from an enumerated object in the Constitution is unauthorized to exist, operate, or function, therefore it must be identified to be discontinued or eliminated in a Republic. Review declaration process.

In preparation for creating a County Constitution, take note of the various checks and balances within the federal Constitution and the intent of separation of the powers and weasel thresholds, reservations of powers, eligibility and such the initial acts for the spirit, intent, and the letter of the laws/acts (e.g. patents and copyrights for a limited time...) to evaluate the original terms, definitions, and intents are referred to those few objects enumerated and how they were enumerated. This includes: 1) all square representation, 2) suffrage in Congress - suffrage of the people in the House based upon the ratio of 30,000 people or U.S. voters and equal representation of the peoples governments in the Senate as well as the purpose for those one separate legislative responsibilities: 3) a guarantee to all governments instituted by We the People (counties, municipalities, etc.) the A Republic in form, 4) contain all the branches of government (e.g. legislative, executive, and a judiciary), and 5) equal protect each party not only from an invasion of foreigners but from foreign/outsider influence in their government (i.e. allowing people from out of state or out of the elect or area from influencing the elections in a town, county, and state), 6) that governments the people institute must be one or certain financially self sufficient, 7) the only direct election of public servants can and must be their representation of the people, and direct all state wide seats or county wide seats are to be selected by an elector of the people, thus requiring a County Elector and Federal Elector at a minimum (i.e. the County Elector will choose the County and State Elector as well as municipal Electors); 8) a clear separation of powers enumerated in the Constitutions; 9) the only currency can be gold silver and precious metal (if paper bill is used, then each bill must be non-transferable to paper metal copies); 10) simultaneous of the restrictions in Article I Sections 9 and 10 that apply; 9) that the process for impeachment is only remain for bad personal behavior and that any all public servants who violated the Constitution or fail to actively support it are instantly removed for their perjury of their oath by violating their oath of office (AW Section 3 of the Fourteenth Amendment and that the Citizens C<sup>2</sup> Committee ensure that such violations are enforced and reported to all States SOG to ensure that the violator will never become a public servant again unless two thirds of both Houses of Congress remove the liability from the individual who is banned; 10) ensure that the jurisdiction of the Judiciary in all cases must arise under the Constitutions, and for all cases that are of equity and laws not within the Constitutions be processed in Common Law courts

Create reports of findings informing all counties in the state of the list of all federal rulings that exceeded the authority of the federal judiciary that have been identified by the C<sup>2</sup> Committee and that these laws must be revoked through Republic Review process.

Promulgate reports to all counties in the state requesting involvement and reports in this process

Create a report and findings and definitions of court jurisdiction, standing and what will be non-justiciable for federal, state, and county courts (i.e. only those objects enumerated in these Constitutions)

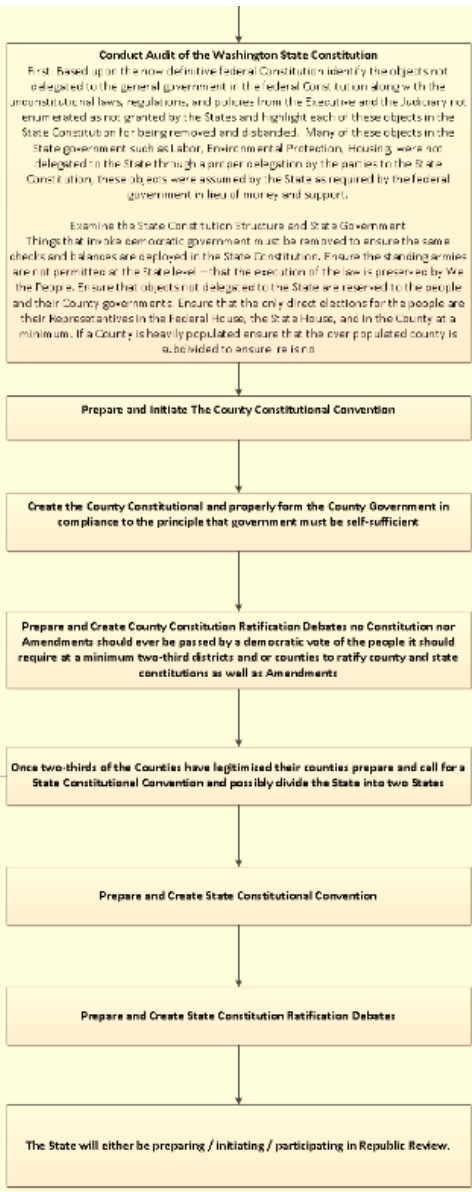
Promulgate report and findings of court jurisdiction, standing and what will be non-justiciable to all counties

Create reports of findings informing all counties in the state of the list of all C<sup>2</sup>'s that exceeded the President's authority; and that these laws must be reviewed through Republic Review

Promulgate Resolution to all States in the US and requesting other States to unite in this process

Creating a table of tyranny to keep track of all violations 1) direct, 2) indirect violations by assumption, 3) indirect violations by laws created by the Executive, 4) indirect violations by laws created by the Judiciary

Provide periodic updates as to finding and progress of the audit

**First Amendment Petition Review subcommittee**

Receive a citizen(s) First Amendment Petition(s). Provide copies to the County Clerk and Commissioners.

Determine if possible whether the petition has standing based on the Constitutional obligations of the County legislators. If the C<sup>2</sup> Committee is unable to determine the standing of the petition based on the language of the petition, then the C<sup>2</sup> Committee will need to do the following if this has not been done:

- 1) If the petition is concerning a matter over the County Constitution then the C<sup>2</sup> Committee will need to conduct an audit of the County Constitution.
- 2) If the petition is concerning a matter over the State Constitution then the C<sup>2</sup> Committee will need to conduct an audit of the States Constitution.
- 3) If the petition is concerning a matter over the Constitution for the United States then the C<sup>2</sup> Committee will need to conduct an audit of the Constitution for the United States of America.

All Constitutions must be created and demand that any public servant who has been Elected for failure to support the Constitution must be charged with a Felony offense for both the act as well as the liability for the cost to the people for starting off as

and an order of arrest or will be submitted

if they are not in the State at the time of the offense/creat a law that this state is demanding full compliance to both the federal Constitution and the State Constitution and that enforcement of the Constitution is the focus. Thus, no lobbyist or public servant supporting a lobbyist or form a committee of new business to consider a petition for an Article V Convention unless a simple majority of the electorate within a simple majority of each legislative district are specifically requesting the consideration of a "specific amendment(s)" to the U.S. Constitution. This is a Republican form of government not a lobbyist form of government.

Ensures all Constitutions actualize the case of enforcement of Section 2 of the 14<sup>th</sup> Amendment—that demands all citizens of the State who serve in any level of public service—including federal—are required to fully comply to the oath in "Actual" supporting the federal Constitution. Failure will be 1) immediate removal from office, 2) lifetime disbarment from public office, 3) there is no allowance for due process for this removal as this is strictly a lifetime indelible to serve in any office of public trust or profit civic failure to support the Constitution for the United States of America.
